

Limited Warranty

Your watch is warranted for a period of one year from the date of purchase.

The warranty covers manufacturing defects only. To be eligible for warranty the watch must be repaired by a Pheidippides Watches certified specialist. The dated and signed warranty card should also be presented. Warranty issues are handled at the discretion of Pheidippides Watches.

The warranty does not cover:

- Defects due to normal wear and tear of the watch, such as but not limited to scratches, stains or dislocation of parts.
- Damages due to accidents, negligence or abusive use of the watch such as but not limited to violent shock, brutal handling, crushing or use of excessive force on any part.
- Glasses, strap and buckle.

The warranty becomes void immediately when the watch is opened by someone other than a certified specialist.


Operation

The Hourglass is easy to operate. The crown normally resides in position 1. Pull out the crown to set it to position 2.

Position 1: run and manual winding (self-winding)
Position 2: time setting (preferably clockwise)

When ready, always push the crown back into position 1.
In position 1 the watch is sealed to 7 bar.

Always check the crown is securely pushed into position 1 before emerging the watch into water. Rinse the watch with fresh water after it has been submerged into salty water.



Care

Keep your watch in great condition by cleaning it regularly with a microfiber cloth. Do not use detergents. This might damage the seals or stain the polished steel surfaces.

A mechanical watch should be kept running. This will avoid the lubricants to congeal. Wind your watch at least twice a month. When unwound, 20 turns of the crown will inject sufficient energy into your watch to start daily use.

Your watch has a water resistance of 7 bar. That means you can take it for a swim or other water related activities. Do not wear it while taking a shower.

Avoid temperature shocks like taking your watch into a sauna or jump into a cold sea.

Avoid excessive or repeated shocks and jolts to the watch. Do not wear while playing golf, tennis or other (high) impact sports.

Avoid exposure to magnetic fields caused by phones, loudspeakers, etc.

To keep your valuable timepiece in top condition have it checked by a certified specialist every 5 years. Check the water resistance every year.
